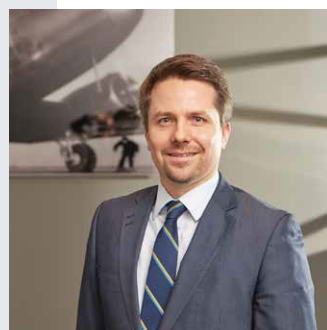
TEACHING TEAM
