This online course will introduce students to fantasy and the fantastic, often defined as the "literature of the impossible".

Students will survey key texts across different media (e.g. by J.R.R. Tolkien and Ursula K. Le Guin, as well as cinematic and TV fantasy), while exploring critical approaches and recent theoretical debates. There is also the opportunity to have a go at writing fantasy.

- Analyse the ways works of fantasy are produced and received within their cultural and socio-historical contexts
