Internships are also open to master students. It is the applicant's sole responsibility to submit the necessary information and documentation.

Documents that interested students must upload:

- Statement of Purpose (one page).
- Updated CV or Resume (one page).
- Transcripts or records of the last academic period (non-official transcripts admitted).
- English or Spanish proficiency tests, if required.
